



# DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY WHAT ARE THE ORIGINS OF THIS GREAT SOLEMNITY? A HISTORY OF MERCY

Christ's entire life can be seen as a testimony to the mercy of God. Salvation history is rich with evidence of this truth. Although the reality of God's great compassion is unmistakably established and confirmed in the history of the Old Testament, it is the coming of His Son that gives the world the actual incarnation of this love and mercy. Pope John Paul's encyclical, Dives in Misericordia ("Rich in Mercy"), observes: "Christ confers on the whole of the Old Testament tradition about God's mercy a definitive meaning. Not only does he speak of it ... but above all he himself makes it incarnate and personifies it. He himself, in a certain sense, is mercy".

#### JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU

Simply speaking, then, the "Divine Mercy" is another name for the revelation of this magnificent love of God, which culminates in the life, death and resurrection of Christ. Christians have long known and praised this abundant mercy. In this sense, devotion to the Divine Mercy is not new.

On Feb. 22, 1931, Jesus first appeared to Sister Mary Faustina Kowalska, a young Polish cloistered nun of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland,. He was clothed in a white robe, with two rays of light emanating from His heart - one red and one white, representing the blood and water that came forth from His pierced side at His crucifixion. He requested that this image be painted with the signature, "Jesus, I trust in You," and promised that even the most hardened sinners who would revere this image would be saved.

Our Lord told Sister Faustina of His great desire that the first Sunday after Easter be dedicated as the "Feast of Mercy," and that this image of His mercy be known and venerated by the whole world. Our Lord appeared to Sister Faustina (whom He called His "apostle of mercy) many other times over the course of several years, each time speaking of His great mercy for all souls. "Mankind will not have peace," He said, "until it turns with trust to My mercy. ... Proclaim that **mercy** is the greatest attribute of God."

#### THE FEĂST OF MERCY

On April 30, 2000, the first Sunday following Easter, Pope John Paul both canonized Sister Faustina Kowalska and declared in his homily that the "Second Sunday of Easter ... from now on throughout the world will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'" It is important to understand that this is not a new feast day in the Church. The feast of Divine Mercy is a continuation of the celebration of Easter; it is, as Pope John Paul once said, Christ's "Easter gift" to the world.

#### "FROM THE HEART OF CHRIST CRUCIFIED"

The Feast of Divine Mercy is not only a beautiful reminder of the love of God, but also a challenge to a deeper understanding of who He is, and who we are in relation to Him. At the Mass for Faustina's canonization, Pope John Paul prayed for her intercession.

Let us join him in this prayer:

"Divine Mercy reaches human beings from the Heart of Christ crucified. ... Today, fixing our gaze with you on the face of the Risen Christ, let us make our own your prayer of trusting abandonment and say with firm hope: 'Jesus, I trust in You!'"

I was reminded of Father Francisco's comments during the Fridays of Lent Services that we are a very diverse parish community. Seeing all of this diversity was incredible! Yet we are all united by our common faith that has brought us to church on Good Friday evening.

The Saturday evening Easter Vigil has always been an incredible experience for me, and this year was no exception. We had a full house in our church (St. Matthias) for this highest celebration in our church year.

I truly believe our choir reached a new high in leading us in prayer throughout this Holy Season! Our Easter Sunday Masses brought everything to a great conclusion – and a good beginning of the Easter Season.

I want to say an additional word of thanks to all of you for your flexibility and cooperation with our efforts to welcome our visitors over the past two weekends. We estimated that we served approximately close to 1,500 persons for our Easter Sunday Masses.

Also, a special thanks to Lisa Yaccoub and Carole Abboud for their hard work in putting together the Easter Egg Hunt and Party for our children! A great time was had by all who attended!

We spent 40 days fasting in preparation for the feast of Easter. Now we are called to spend 50 days feasting in celebration. Let's maintain our initial enthusiasm throughout all of the days of this season
